Dear Josh:

Per your request, I have re-inspected and evaluated the trees recommended for re-inspection in the "Tree Removal and Replacement Plan for the Gates at Bouldercrest" report I prepared on January 19, 2007. I also checked the status of the trees recommended for removal and pruning. In addition, I inspected and evaluated the trees in the park. Attached are the updated spreadsheets for the trees in the removal and replacement plan and a new spreadsheet listing trees recommended for removal or pruning in the park area.

The updated information for the trees in the removal and replacement plan are in italics. 58 of the 69 trees recommended for removal have been removed and 3 others have been removed. Most of the trees recommended to be pruned have been properly pruned; however, I have recommended pruning for several of the trees. I have also recommended removal of some of the silver maples that have problems. As I discussed in the January 19, 2007 report, the silver maples will eventually outgrow their growing space; therefore, some property owners may want to have the silver maples removed and replaced with the tree species recommended in the 2007 report. I recommend re-inspection of the remaining trees listed in the removal and replacement plan in two years.

Regarding the park trees, I have recommended removal of 10 trees and pruning of 2 trees. I recommend a re-inspection of these trees in one year.

The advice I have given and recommendations I have made to you in no way guarantee that any of the trees at the Gates at Bouldercrest will not fail. Trees are living organisms that are subject to the many elements of nature, which means they can fail at any time.
